


#### Valentine Acrostic Poem














### Valentines Fortune Teller



Cut out this fortune teller - write fortunes, messages, dares or loves on each of the triangles in the centre. Crease along all the lines on the template. Then bring the corners to the center of the paper. Start with one of the bottom corners and fold it to the middle of the paper where the creases intersect. Turn your paper 90 degrees and fold the other bottom corner toward the center. Keep rotating and folding your paper until you've made a smaller square containing four triangles. Flip the paper over and fold each corner to the center again. Google how to fold a paper fortune teller if you aren't sure - there are plenty of videos showing you how to.
